The program is part of swim lessons but will be taught by a swim team coach. The goal of the program should be to help the swimmers swim a full 25/50 freestyle and backstroke without stopping and possibly work on being legal in all 4 strokes. If your child is enrolled in youth camp, transportation will not be provided to youth camp. Swimmers will need to be able to swim. If you cannot swim you will be moved to swim lessons. If swimmers are already legal in all 4 strokes, you should be on the swim team. Participants would be allowed come to one home swim meet and swim 25/50 freestyle meet.
